Information for Centres

The prelim paper begins on page 2

This prelim paper covering all three units of the SQA **Higher Mathematics** course has been produced by Dynamic Maths to be used either as a full prelim in its own right, or as a basis for Centres to produce their own prelims.

Centres are free to adapt and edit this prelim as they see fit in order to meet the needs of their candidates. The prelim has been produced and supplied in Microsoft Word format so that it is fully editable (note – some equations were originally created with MathType. It is possible that you may not be able to edit them if you do not have this software, but you would be able to delete them and replace them with an equation written in Microsoft's Equation Editor). The mark scheme has been produced in Microsoft Excel format so that it is also fully editable.

It is recognised that Centres are free to edit and use this prelim as they see fit, and the files have not been protected or secured in order to allow schools to do this. However the following code-of-practice is requested:

- It is requested that Centres retain the Dynamic Maths logo and branding on each page.
- It is requested that Centres overwrite the text saying 'Type Over this Text with Name of Centre' with their Centre name which will then be automatically repeated on each page.
- It is **strongly requested** for the benefit of all other Centres using this prelim that Centres maintain the security of this prelim by:
 - Storing paper and electronic copies in a secure place.
 - Ensuring all copies of the papers are taken back in after the completion of the assessment (and any follow up discussion etc.)
 - Not making the questions accessible to candidates on Centre servers, websites, or via email **until after June 2019**.

It is important that this is adhered to, as if one Centre were to allow the questions into the public domain, this could compromise the integrity of the prelim for all other Centres across Scotland.

- It is requested that if Centres use any of the questions or diagrams (authored by Dynamic Maths) from this prelim in their own resources after June 2019 that appropriate credit to 'Dynamic Maths Prelim: Higher 2018-2019' is given.

Whilst we have tried in good faith to produce a prelim paper that emulates SQA papers and meets all requirements of the national standard, it is not possible to guarantee that this prelim will be accepted by the SQA as part of their Results Service or Post-Results Service.
